- > All members and guests are asked to **register** in the registration binder as it is passed in from the outside aisle. These will be collected at the end of the service. Please be sure to fill in first and last name.
- > If you are in need of a **nursery**, we have two available in the Preschool Education wing. There is an unattended nursery for mothers with infants in room 104 and an attended nursery for children ages 2 and under in room 111. We ask that you respect these age limits. Please see an usher if you need help locating the nursery. The nursery has a pager system so you can feel comfortable leaving your child knowing they can get in touch with you if there is a problem.
- > **Children's Worship** meets every Sunday of the month except the first one. It is for ages 3 through Kindergarten. Children will be dismissed from the worship service during the song before the sermon to attend Children's Worship. Parents may exit during the closing song to pick them up. They meet in room 102 in the Preschool Education wing.

- > We meet in **Life Groups** during the school year every Sunday night except on fifth Sundays. Life Groups are a house to house ministry focusing on the spiritual intimacy and fellowship that a small devotional group allows us to have. If you are not involved in a Sunday evening group, we urge you to become involved.
- > **Men's Prayer Group** meets every Wednesday at 6:30 in the front corner classroom of the Adult Education wing.

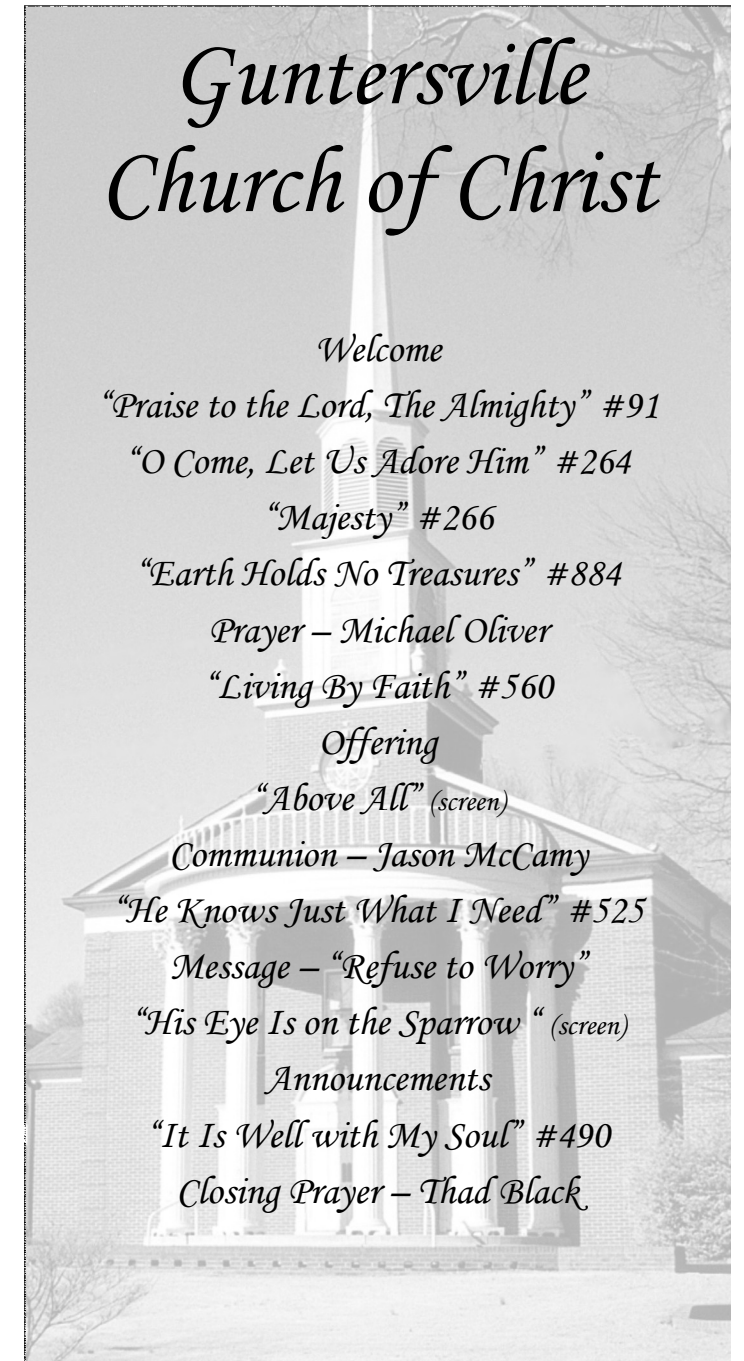

LIFE GROUP STUDIES—WINTER, 2012 LIVING A LIFE OF INTEGRITY: “REFUSE TO WORRY”

TEXT: Matthew 6:25-34

INTRODUCTION: Jesus doesn’t want you to worry your life away. He doesn’t want you to be so consumed with how He will take care of you that you try to take matters into your own hands. There is one particularly unusual thing about worry. It is not the big things that concern us. It is a lot of little things that tend to add up. Last week, we discussed the need to prioritize our lives in such a way that material things not overwhelm us. Isn’t it interesting that Jesus follows the previous section with today’s discussion about worry. The point is obvious. If you do not get your priorities in line with the will of God, then you will find yourself worrying about every little thing that causes stress and dismay in your life. So, what is the solution? The passage to day outlines one requirement. Simply stated, “Don’t worry,” Jesus says. But saying it is one thing, living it is more involved. Jesus then defines how you are to live the requirement.

1. What are some of the things you find yourself worrying about?
2. How would you define “worry”? What makes it different from “concern”?

DIG

3. Read Philippians 4:6-7. How does this passage compliment what Jesus says in Matthew 6?
4. In what ways does worry affect your Christian influence?

REFLECT

5. What are some of the things people “run after”?
6. Review the following directives. Which is the more difficult for you? What suggestions could you offer to make them more attainable?
 - a. Focus on the eternal, not the temporary.
 - b. Live one day at a time.
 - c. Trust the truth that your Heavenly Father is in control.
